- <u>Curriculum & Discipleship</u>: Oversee the selection, preparation, and implementation of curriculum that aligns with Rock Creek's beliefs and vision for children's discipleship.
- Events & Camps: Plan and execute events, camps, and retreats that foster spiritual growth and community within the 4th and 5th Grade Ministry.
- <u>Collaboration & Teamwork</u>: Work closely with Aubree Lund, the Children's Ministry Director, and the Rock Creek Kids team to ensure alignment with the church's overall vision and ministry goals.
