- destroying angels in Psalm 78:49
- lying spirits in 1 Kings 22:22-23
- The fall of mankind and the entrance of sin into the world involves an Old Testament encounter between Eve and Satan, our personal adversary. (Genesis 3)
- Job is oppressed by Satan. Job 2
- The world is flooded because of demonic activity and the sinful response of man. Demons are real. Genesis 6
