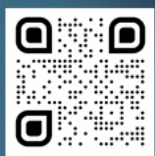

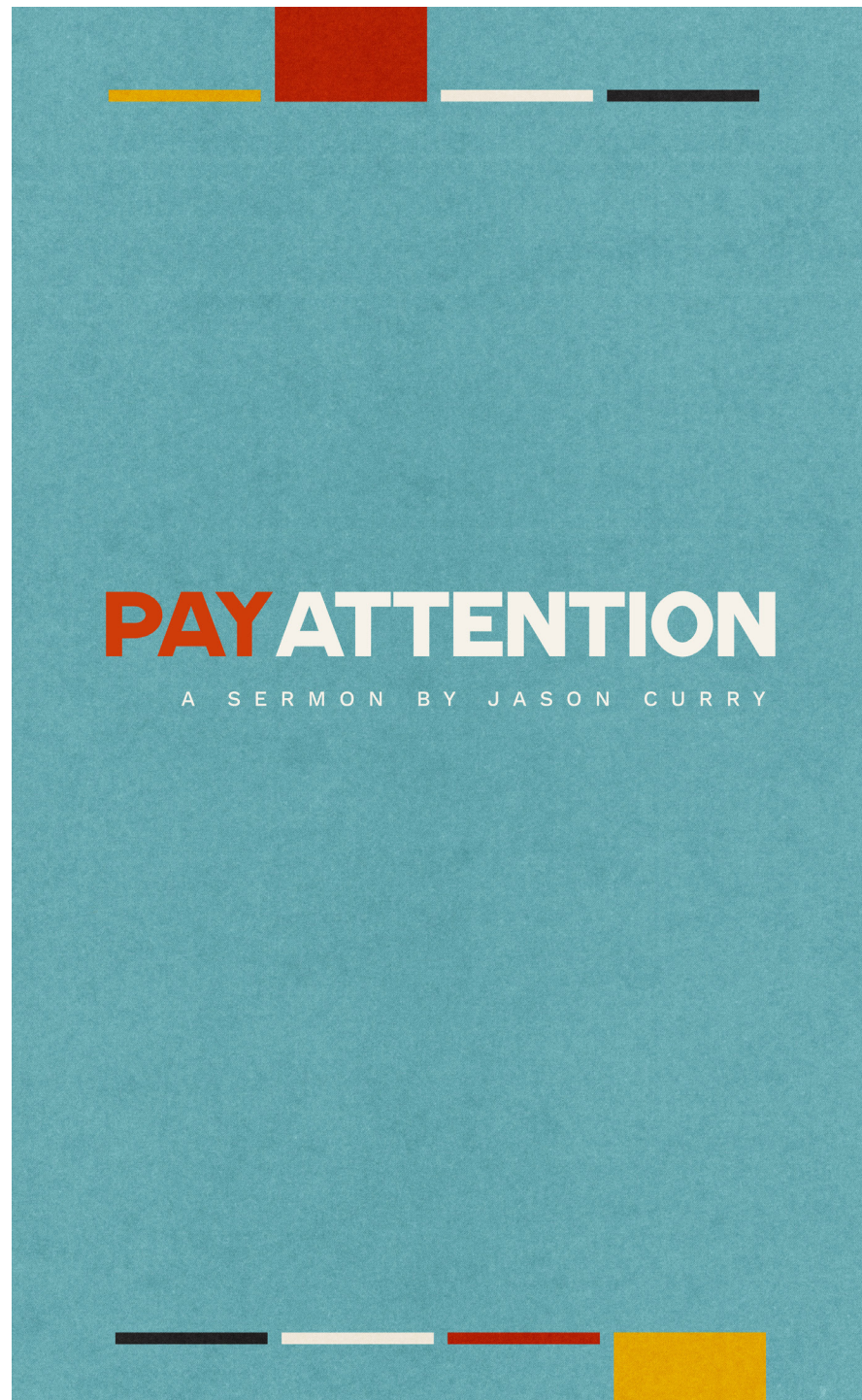

PAY ATTENTION

A SERMON BY JASON CURRY

Pay careful attention, then, to how you walk—not as unwise people but as wise—making the most of the time, because the days are evil. So don't be foolish, but understand what the Lord's will is.

Ephesians 5:15-17

The first three chapters of Ephesians focus on who we are in Christ. Then Paul shifts to how we should live because of it: “walk worthy of the calling you have received.” In chapter 5, he says walk in love, walk as children of light, and pay careful attention to how you walk. Because Jesus has changed who you are, pay attention to how you live. Don't drift. Live wisely and intentionally.

1. PAY ATTENTION TO _____.

Pay careful attention, then, to how you walk—not as unwise people but as wise.

Your direction today is shaping your destination tomorrow.

- Where is the way I'm living actually leading me?
- Are my daily choices moving me toward Jesus or away from Him?
- Are the people closest to me helping me become more like Jesus?
- Am I walking wisely or simply following the crowd?
- What step do I need to take today to move in the right direction?

2. PAY ATTENTION TO _____.

Making the most of the time, because the days are evil.

Your time is limited. Make it count for what matters most.

- Does my calendar reflect what I say matters most?
- What am I giving time to that doesn't deserve it?
- Am I busy with good things but missing the most important things?
- What do I need to say no to so I can say yes to what matters most?
- Am I making the most of this season God has given me?

3. PAY ATTENTION TO _____.

So don't be foolish, but understand what the Lord's will is.

God's will isn't just something to discover; it's something to obey.

- Am I seeking God's will or simply seeking His approval of mine?
- What has God already made clear that I haven't obeyed?
- Do I want God's will even when it conflicts with what I want?
- Am I waiting for God to reveal something new while ignoring what He has already said?
- Is Scripture shaping my life, or are my feelings, other people, and culture?
