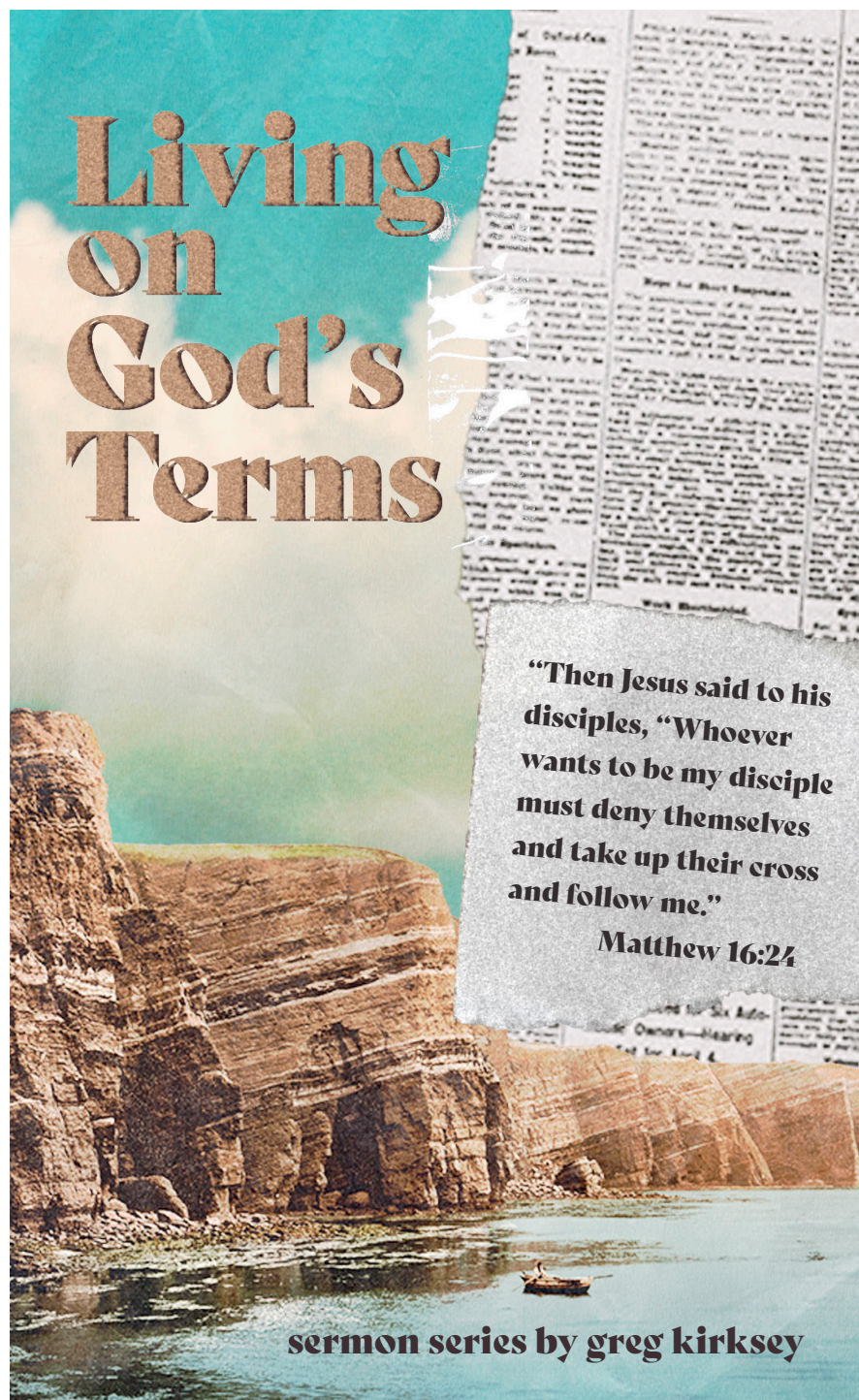

Focal Passage:

Then Jesus said to His disciples, 'If anyone would come after me, he must deny himself and take up his cross and follow me. For whoever wants to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for me will find it.

What good will it be for a man if he gains the whole world, yet forfeits his soul?

Or what can a man give in exchange for his soul?'

1. _____ OF CHRISTIAN DISCIPLESHIP.

'I will follow you wherever you go...' v. 57

'Foxes have dens to live in, and birds have nests, but the Son of Man has no place even to lay his head.' - v. 58

2. _____ TO COMMITTED DISCIPLESHIP.

The man agreed, but he said, 'Lord, first let me return home and bury my father.' v. 59

Let the spiritually dead bury their own dead!

3. _____ OF CONDITIONAL DISCIPLESHIP.

Another said, 'Yes, Lord, I will follow you, but first let me say good-bye to my family.' - v. 61
