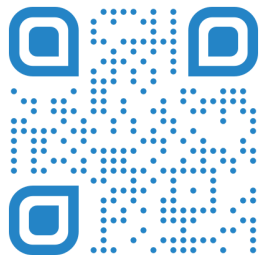
Monday Night Bible Study with Greg Kirksey

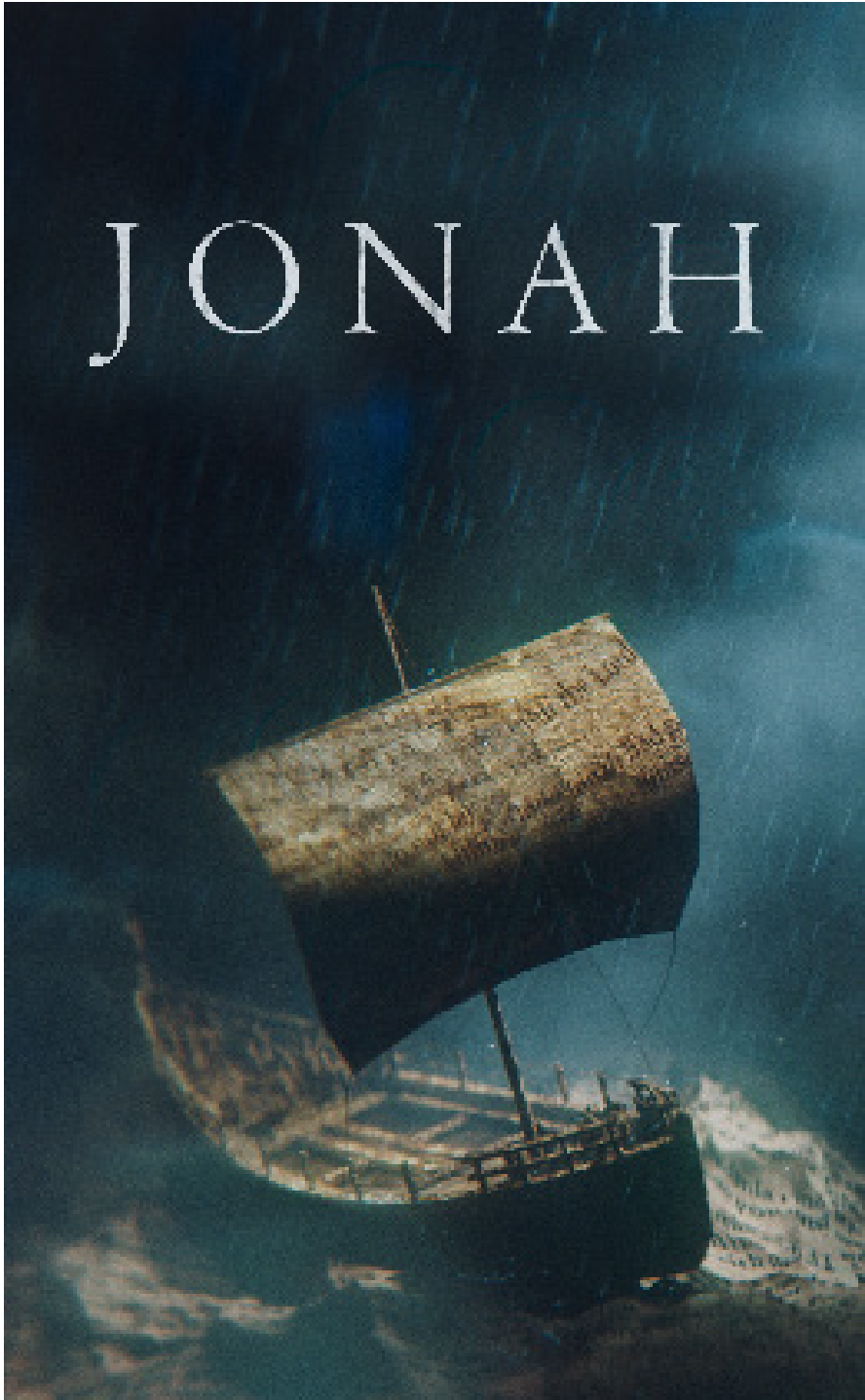

focal passage:
