1. PRAYER	

LESSON:

Darius decided to appoint 120 satraps over the kingdom, stationed throughout the realm, and over them three administrators, including Daniel. v. 1

Seek the welfare of the city I have deported you to. Pray to the Lord on it's behalf, for when it has prosperity, you will prosper. – Jeremiah 29:7 (HCSB)

2. PRAYER

Daniel distinguished himself above the administrators and satraps because he had an extraordinary spirit, so the king planned to set him over the whole realm. -v.3

The administrators and satraps, therefore, kept trying to find a charge against Daniel regarding the kingdom. But they could find no charge or corruption, for he was trustworthy, and no negligence or corruption was found in him. – v. 4

Then these men said, 'We will never find any charge against this Daniel unless we find something against him concerning the law of his God. -v. 5

When Daniel learned that the document had been signed, he went into his house.

The windows in the upper room opened toward Jerusalem, and three times
a day he got down on his knees, prayed, and gave thanks to his God,
just as he had done before. - v. 10

THE LION'S DEN: READ VS. 11-18

At the first light of dawn the king got up and hurried to the lion's den. When he reached the den, he cried out in anguish to Daniel, "Daniel, servant of the living God," the king said, "has your God whom you serve continually been able to rescue you from the lions?" – v. 20

Then Daniel spoke with the king: "May the king live forever. My God sent His angel and shut the lion's mouths. They haven't hurt me, for I was found innocent before Him. Also, I have not committed a crime against you my king." – v. 21-22
