HOW DO I HAVE A BIG IMPACT?

On one occasion an expert in the law stood up to test Jesus. "Teacher," he asked, "what must I do to inherit eternal life?" ²⁶ "What is written in the Law?" he replied. "How do you read it?" 27 He answered, "'Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength and with all your mind'; and, 'Love your neighbor as yourself.'" ²⁸ "You have answered correctly," Jesus replied. "Do this and you will live." ²⁹ But he wanted to justify himself, so he asked Jesus, "And who is my neighbor?" - Luke 10:25-29

MY REACTIONS DETERMINE MY IMPACT

1. THE ______ NEIGHBOR

In reply Jesus said: "A man was going down from Jerusalem to Jericho, when he was attacked by robbers. They stripped him of his clothes, beat him and went away, leaving him half dead. ³¹ A priest happened to be going down the same road, and when he saw the man, he passed by on the other side. - Luke 10:30-31

2. THE ______ NEIGHBOR

"In the same way a Levite also came there, went over and looked at the man, but then walked on by on the other side." - Luke 10:32

3. THE ______ NEIGHBOR

"But a Samaritan, as he traveled, came where the man was; and when he saw him, he took pity on him." - Luke 10:33

MY LOVE MULTIPLIES MY IMPACT

1. I MUST LOOK AT WHAT

"When he saw the man's condition, his heart went out to him." - Luke 10:33(msg)

"Look out for the good of others." - 1 Corinthians 10:24(ncv)

2. I MUST LISTEN FOR HOW

"When he saw him, his heart was filled with compassion." - Luke 10:33

3. I MUST LEARN HOW ____

"He went to him and bandaged his wounds, pouring on oil and wine." - Luke 10:34

Do not withhold good from those who deserve it when it's in your power to help them. ²⁸ If you can help your neighbor now, don't say,"Come back tomorrow, and then I'll help you." - Proverbs 3:27-28

4. I MUST LOVE

Then he put the man on his own donkey, brought him to an inn and took care of him. ³⁵ The next day he took out two denarii and gave them to the innkeeper. 'Look after him,' he said, 'and when I return, I will reimburse you for any extra expense you may have.' - Luke 10:34-35

Feed the hungry, and help those in trouble. Then your light will shine out from the darkness, and the darkness around you will be as bright as noon. "The Lord will guide you continually, giving you water when you are dry and restoring your strength. You will be like a well-watered garden, like an ever-flowing spring. - Isaiah 58:10-11

"Which of these three do you think was a neighbor to the man who fell into the hands of robbers?" ³⁷ The expert in the law replied, "The one who had mercy on him." Jesus told him, "Go and do likewise." - Luke 10:36-37
