





1 Samuel 18:1-8

When David had finished speaking with Saul, Jonathan committed himself to David, and loved him as much as he loved himself.

² Saul kept David with him from that day on and did not let him return to his father's house.

³ Jonathan made a covenant with David because he loved him as much as himself. ⁴ Then Jonathan removed the robe he was wearing and gave it to David, along with his military tunic, his sword, his bow, and his belt.

1 Samuel 18:1-4

Saul's son Jonathan had a son whose feet were crippled. He was five years old when the report came from Jezreel that Saul and Jonathan had been killed in battle. The one who had nursed him picked him up and fled, but as she was hurrying to flee, she dropped him and became crippled. His name was Mephibosheth.

2 Samuel 4:4
