

JESUS _____ OUR _____
Matthew 26:31–35

Then Jesus said to them, “Tonight all of you will fall away because of me, for it is written: I will strike the shepherd, and the sheep of the flock will be scattered.

³² But after I have risen, I will go ahead of you to Galilee.” ³³ Peter told him, “Even if everyone falls away because of you, I will never fall away.” ³⁴ “Truly I tell you,” Jesus said to him, “tonight, before the rooster crows, you will deny me three times.” ³⁵ “Even if I have to die with you,” Peter told him, “I will never deny you.”
And all the disciples said the same thing.

Matthew 26:69–75a

Now Peter was sitting outside in the courtyard. A servant girl approached him and said, “You were with Jesus the Galilean too.” ⁷⁰ But he denied it in front of everyone: “I don’t know what you’re talking about.” ⁷¹ When he had gone out to the gateway, another woman saw him and told those who were there, “This man was with Jesus the Nazarene!” ⁷² And again he denied it with an oath: “I don’t know the man!” ⁷³ After a little while those standing there approached and said to Peter, “You really are one of them, since even your accent gives you away.” ⁷⁴ Then he started to curse and to swear with an oath, “I don’t know the man!” Immediately a rooster crowed, ^{75a} and Peter remembered the words Jesus had spoken, “Before the rooster crows, you will deny me three times.”

Peter stood up with the Eleven, raised his voice, and proclaimed to them: “Fellow Jews and all you residents of Jerusalem, let this be known to you, and pay attention to my words...

³⁶ Therefore let all the house of Israel know with certainty that God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified, both Lord and Messiah.” ³⁷ When they heard this, they were pierced to the heart and said to Peter and the rest of the apostles: “Brothers, what should we do?” ³⁸ Peter replied, “Repent and be baptized, each of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins, and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.”
